







- Records information **manually** on a **worksheet**

- **Proper** and **consistent** data is needed for her physicians to make a **diagnosis**.





- Conveys **information** regarding her condition.



# Description of Preliminary Prototype




- Made to demonstrate basic functionality, layout, and features.
- 4 main pages: home, symptoms, mood, and summary.




- Added 3 **sub** pages: symptom localization, privacy policy, data trends.

- Made symptom **tracking** page functional






- 1. Make each page fully functional.
